

# IGNITE ~ Women's Bible Study Time With God

April 9-14

**MEMORY VERSE:** Proverbs 2:7-8 He stores up sound wisdom for the upright;  
He is a shield to those who walk in integrity, Guarding the paths of justice,  
And He preserves the way of His godly ones.

## FRIDAY, APRIL 9th ~ FEAR GOD

**Pray:** Ask the Holy Spirit to give you a hunger and desire for the inspiration of the Word, and wisdom and insight to comprehend it.

**Read:** Psalm 15

**Observe:** Who will dwell in the tent of God?

List the different statements that are made in this passage that describe what integrity looks like in action and deed.

**Think about it:** Take each of the statements above and put it into today's terms. Describe the virtue with a real situation. (ie. "speaks truth in his heart" could be "what I say to myself about myself, situations, and others will be truth based on God's Word, I will not lie to myself or exaggerate.")

**Apply:** What actions, attitudes, practices, etc. do you have in your life that reflects the virtues in this passage?

What virtues or actions do you need to work on to be a woman of integrity?



## SATURDAY, APRIL 10th ~ FEAR OF MAN

**Pray:** Spend some time praising the Lord that you are His daughter.

**Read:** Psalm 25:16-23

**Observe:** What is the present situation the psalmist finds himself in? Describe in your own words.

**Think About it:** How tempting is it to walk in integrity when we are faced with great obstacles or difficulties?

What is the Psalmist's point of walking in integrity in the midst of the storm?

**Apply:** What situation have you found yourself in, where you needed to make a decision to walk in integrity regardless of what you were facing? How did God meet you in your choice to be faithful?

If you have struggled with be able to walk in integrity in difficult times, pray this through with the Lord and ask Him to help you.

## MONDAY, APRIL 12th ~ FEAR

**Pray:** Express to the Lord your hearts desire to know Him more intimately. Ask Him to reveal more of Himself to you today.

**Read:** Psalm 26

Observe: What point is the psalmist making about his choice to walk in integrity? Why is he reminding God?

What decisions, actions does the psalmist describe as walking in integrity?

Think about it: Look at the different choices he made. If you measure your life up to this psalm, note the places that you are walking in victory or have improved in.

Apply: Note the areas that you need to take a look at, what situations are you finding yourself in where you need to apply these principles?

## TUESDAY, APRIL 13th ~ FEAR NOT

Pray: Take some time to pray about your life and ask the Lord to show you about areas of your life that you need to address concerning integrity.

Read: Psalm 78

Observe: What has God had to deal with through the choices of His people?

Think about it: What does the last verse of the Psalm tell you about God?

Apply: What hope or encouragement does this psalm give you concerning God's integrity?



## WEDNESDAY, APRIL 14th ~ PEACE

Pray: Ask the Lord to speak to you today. Ask Him to increase your ability to hear His voice.

Read: Proverbs 2

Observe: Write out verse 7:

Think about it: What is this psalm teaching us about the key to walking in integrity?

Apply: What is God saying to you through the passages of scripture this week?
