Discussion Questions for November 17th / November 18th

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Is it really possible to get to know the God of the universe in a personal way? Why or why not? What are some ways that Christians can get to know God personally? Read John 17:3 after you have answered this question.
2. What does being fully committed to someone or something look like? Why does God want us to commit to Him fully?
3. Read Luke 9:62. What does this verse teach us about giving a half-hearted commitment to God?
4. Read Matthew 16:24-26. What does complete commitment look like according to Jesus?
5. Read Revelation 3:15-16. Why does God have such an issue with people who are lukewarm? Why is being spiritually lukewarm so dangerous?
6. Read Nehemiah 9:38. Why is it important to take our commitments and put them in writing?

7. Read Haggai 1:3-7. Have you been putting God first in the area of your finances? Why or why not?
