**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. Read Ephesians 5:15-16. Our perspective of time is foundational to experiencing a new life in Christ. Why do we have to be careful how we live? What does it look like to make the most of every opportunity?
2. Read Colossians 3:2. What happens to our lives when we are focused on eternity rather than what this world has to offer?
3. Read Matthew 6:19-21. What does it mean to store up treasures in Heaven?
4. Read Mark 12:30-31. Why does God want everything that we do to revolve around loving Him and loving others?
5. Our motivation drives our actions. Why is it important to regularly reflect on what is personally motivating the different parts of our lives?
