DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What were your personal thoughts when you heard Pastor Chuck teach us that forgiveness is an emotion? Do you agree or disagree?
2. What happens to us physically and spiritually when we choose not to forgive others when they have wronged us?
3. Read Matthew 18:21-22. What important lesson does Jesus teach us in this scripture?
4. Why is it important to forgive from the heart? What happens when our forgiveness is not sincere?
5. Read Matthew 7:1-5. How does this verse tie in to the idea of forgiveness?
6. Read Matthew 6:14-15. What does Jesus teach us about forgiveness in this scripture? What kind of emotions do you experience when you read this difficult truth?
7. Read Hebrews 12:14-15. What does the Lord want us to work towards? What happens when we let bitterness spring up in our lives?

LIVE "LIFE" NOW:

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One of the most loving things that you can do as a person is to forgive those that have hurt or wronged you. When you choose not to forgive, you become bitter and it infects every part of your life. Are there people in your life that you need to forgive with your heart? This week pray to the Lord that He brings people to mind that you need to forgive. Ask the Lord to open doors and opportunities to be able to reconcile and make things right with those individuals.
