KICKING IT OFF: Where do you prefer spending most of your time? Why?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why do you think that some people find it difficult to grasp the idea that the God of the universe wants to have a personal relationship with us?
2. Read Ecclesiastes 3:11. What has God made beautiful in its time? What does it mean that He put eternity into our hearts? Why is this important for us to know and understand?
3. Now read Romans 8:28. How does this scripture relate to Ecclesiastes 3:11. What can you count on that God will do for us when we give Him enough time?
4. Read Exodus 3:10-15. What is God’s name? What does this tell you about God?
5. Read 2 Peter 3:8. What does this tell you about God and His view of time?
6. Read Malachi 3:6 and 1 Samuel 15:29. What does this tell you about God? What can you trust about God?

7. Read Isaiah 57:15. Since God can live anywhere, what is the significance that God would choose to live within our heart if we choose to accept Jesus as our savior?

8. Read Psalm 89:11. Since God created everything (and you) and owns everything, how should this affect how we live? How should we treat His creation?
