## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. The Bible Teaches us that God is all powerful, all present and all knowing. Why are these characteristics foundational to who God is?
2. Read Romans 8:28-39. What do these scriptures teach us about God? What promises can we trust in if we are His? What does this mean to you as you think about how God loves you and what He will do for you?
3. Read Job 42:1-2. Job said these words when he was enduring suffering and loss that few have ever experienced. What did Job say that he knew is true of God?
4. Read Jeremiah 32:17-20. Jeremiah had just experienced God speaking to him and doing a miracle for him. What does Jeremiah say is true of God?
5. Read Mark 10:23-31. What does Jesus tell us about God? What does Jesus tell us God will do for those who completely commit their lives to Him?
6. Read Proverbs 15:3. What does this tell us about God?

7. Read Isaiah 40:28-31. What does this tell us about God's understanding? What do we need to do so that we will experience God giving us strength and energy?
  
8. Read Isaiah 55:8-13. What does this tell you about God? What does this tell you about God's Word?

God reveals in the Bible that He is Omnipotent, Omnipresent and Omniscient. Omnipotent means that He is All Powerful. There is nothing impossible to God and nothing in your life that He cannot handle. Omnipresent means that God is everywhere and will always be with you. Omniscient means that God is All Knowing. God knows everything therefore there is nothing that God does not know.

As you reflect on these truths about God, what are some of the thoughts and emotions that come to mind? Do you experience shame, guilt, wonder, or awe? As you reflect on what is in your heart, ask the Lord to bring you into a more intimate relationship with Him. Ask Him to use His characteristics of being Omnipotent, Omnipresent and Omniscient to draw you closer to Him.
