Discussion Questions for June 12^{th} /June 16^{th}

KICKING IT OFF: What did you get into the most trouble for with your parents as a kid?

MEMORY VERSE: "And we are witnesses of these things; and *so is* the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey Him."

Acts 5:32 NASB

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Read 2 Corinthians 3:17-18. Who is the Lord? What are you told about the Lord and about the Holy Spirit? Why is this meaningful?
- 2. Read John 14:16-17. What does Jesus do so that you will get the Holy Spirit? Who sends the Holy Spirit to you? How long will He be with you if you know Him?
- 3. What does Jesus call the Holy Spirit in the previous passages? What does that tell you the Holy Spirit does when He is active in our lives?
- 4. Read Acts 1:7-8 and Luke 24:45-49. What happens when the Holy Spirit comes upon us. What are we to do when the Holy Spirit comes upon us? Why is this important?
- 5. Read Acts 5:32. Who is the Holy Spirit given to? Who is the Holy Spirit not given to?

- 6. Read John 7:37-39. What is the description of what occurs when you receive the Holy Spirit?
- 7. Read Isaiah 58:11. What is our life supposed to be like when we are filled with the Holy Spirit?

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This week we learned that we can "quench" the Holy Spirit. The word quench means to extinguish and has the idea of pouring water on a fire. It also is like the crimping of a garden hose. The scriptures also teach us that we can "grieve" the Holy Spirit. This is because the Holy Spirit is not a thing, He is a person. The word grieve means to cause grief, to make sad, to cause sorrow.

This week reflect on this question, "Are there any areas in my life that I am grieving or quenching the Holy Spirit?" Reach out to God and He will extend out His loving hand and lead you to freedom!
