Discussion Questions for September 25th /September 29th

**KICKING IT OFF:** If you could live in any sitcom, which would it be and why?

**MEMORY VERSE:** “But to all who believed him and accepted him, he gave the right to become children of God.”

John 1:12 NLT

**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. Read Genesis 1:26-31 and Psalm 139. If you want to know your purpose, why is it important that you must begin with God?

2. Read John 10:10 in the NLT. What is Jesus’ purpose for you? Now read Jeremiah 29:11-13. If we must begin with God, how does this passage say that God can be found?

3. Solomon had everything he could ever dream of and still ended up having a void in his life. At the end of his life he discovered that fearing God and responding to His commandments was all that mattered and where he found true purpose. Is there anything in your life that you may be putting before God?

4. This week we learned that every believer has a gift; what are some of your gifts? Have you discovered your spiritual gifts in our Next Step classes?

5. Read John 15:1-11. What is the promise that we can count on if you and I live by these truths?

6. Every believer should have people that are far from God that we are investing in relationally. Do you have people in your life? Take a moment in your group and talk about this. If you don't have people in your life, ask that God would reveal those people to you so that you can start investing relationally.

7. Our work in the Lord is never in vain and always has a reward. Take time and pray as group and ask God to help you fulfill your purpose.
