6. Read John 1:1, 1:14, 1:18. What do these scriptures teach us about Jesus?
7. Read Romans 5:8-9. What purpose did Jesus fulfill for us?
8. Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-6 and 14-17. What is important about these scriptures? Why is this truth foundational to our Christian faith?
