DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Tell about a time that someone told you something that was true but was really hard to hear. How did you respond? Did you end up appreciating it?
2. Tell about a time when the truth was refreshing or brought a foundation from which you could work from?
3. Read John 14:6. Why can't everyone just live out their own truth?
4. Why do you think Jesus's statement in this verse is offensive to our world today?
5. Day 47 took us through some difficult truths. Which was most difficult for you? Why?
6. Read John 16:13. Talk about a time when the Holy Spirit lead you into truth, at work, with your kids, at home, or in a relationship.

7. Day 42 talked about how our responsibility as Christians to share the truth with those who don't know the truth. How are you doing as an ambassador for Christ? For whom are you consistently praying will come to know Christ? How can you be more intentional to live out your role as an ambassador this week?
