DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Please share with the group your two most dominant spiritual pathways? Did it take long to figure it out? Or did the answer pop off the page? What spiritual pathways do you think Jesus had?
2. Read Matthew 26:30, Ephesians 5:19 and Revelation 6:9-10. What do these scriptures reveal about the importance of worship in song?
3. How much time, do you think, people should spend thinking, reflecting or meditating? Please read Colossians 3:2 and Philippians 4:8. What is Paul suggesting we think about in these two passages?
4. Read Jesus’ declaration about Himself in Mark 10:45. Do you have a ministry that you fulfill in the life of the church? What is it?

5. Read Luke 2:46-52. Do you think Jesus knew everything instantly or had to grow? How do you think He grew in His knowledge and wisdom?
6. Look at Psalm 8:1, and Psalm 19:1. How does God reveal Himself through nature? According to Romans 1:20-23, what danger exists in appreciating nature too much?
7. Read Acts 2:42, 2 Corinthians 6:14 and 1 John 1:3. Is friendship the same as fellowship? What is unique about fellowship? Who is our fellowship with?
8. Have you ever gone on a mission trip? Which one? What was the work and ministry? Who was involved? What change did God do in you?
