**MEMORY VERSE FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH:** "Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful."

Joshua 1:8

**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

1. Share with the group: Are you a dog person or a cat person?
2. Share with the group something that God taught you or is teaching you during your personal Bible reading time.
3. What was your main take-away from what Pastor Chuck taught us through his message *When All Hell Breaks Loose*?
4. Read Romans 13:1-5. Do you personally have a difficult time accepting this truth? Why is this important during difficult times?
5. Read Luke 21:10-11 and Revelation 6:7-8. What do these verses describe will happen in the last days? Do you personally believe that we are living in the last days? Why or why not?
6. Read 2 Timothy 1:7. According to this scripture, what are we not suppose to do?

**LIVE "ITEL" NOW:**

7. Read Philippians 2:3-4. The early church endured 2 deadly plagues but these early Christians handled them differently than the rest of the world. They showed love by taking care of those who were cast aside and left for dead.

Pastor Chuck taught us that “when all hell breaks loose” Christians should do 3 things: pray about everything, give instead of hoard, serve others instead of preserving yourself. Which of these 3 most stood out to you personally? Is there one that you need to work on this week?
