2 Corinthians 4:1

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Share with the group: What is the movie or TV show you have watched the most in your lifetime?
2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you or is teaching you during your personal Bible reading time?
3. Pastor Chuck shared in his message that we hear the word "death" every day now. What type of effect do you think this has on people's mental health?
4. Look at Paul in the Bible, he lived a drastically different life because he did not fear death. As Christians, we are not to be afraid of death! How do we begin to be Christians that are described as courageous? Do you personally fear death?
5. Let's read 2 Corinthians 5:1-4. What do these scriptures teach us about differentiating between temporary and eternal? What are our bodies compared to here?
6. Let's read 1 John 2:16-17 and John 6:27. What do these scriptures teach us about having an eternal perspective rather than a worldly perspective? Who do we need to put our trust in?

7. Now as a group, let's read 2 Corinthians 5:6-8. What important truth do we learn in these verses about how we can always be courageous in any situation?
