**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. Share with the group: What is your favorite sport or physical activity?
2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you or is teaching you during your personal Bible reading time?
3. What was your main take-away from Josh McDowell’s message this week?
4. How do you personally define truth? What does Jesus say about truth in John 14:6?
5. Josh McDowell shared that one of the most powerful things that we can do is share our story with others (Before Christ, What Happened, Now What). Do you agree or disagree? Why is our story so important for us to share our story with others as a Christians?
6. Josh talked about the difference between convictions and a belief system. He said a conviction is: 1. Knowing what you believe 2. Knowing why you believe 3. Experience it in your life. Let’s read Joshua 1:8 together. How do we begin to have more conviction in our lives?
7. Josh talked about the importance of being prepared and having a clear conscience. Let’s read Hebrews 13:18. How can we be prepared to share our faith? What does it mean to have a clear conscience? Why is it important to have a clear conscience when it comes to apologetics?
