DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Share with the group: What talent would you most like to grow and develop?
2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you, or is teaching you, during your personal Bible reading time?
3. What was your main take-away from Pastor Chuck's message this week?
4. Read Isaiah 36:4-7. Have you ever had a problem or trial so difficult that you thought you might not make it through? Did you have others telling you that God would not be enough to help you?
5. Read Isaiah 37:35-37. There is no battle that God cannot handle with even one of his Angels. Is there a battle, a habit or addiction that you have thought is just impossible to beat? Are you willing to share, have hope and trust in the Lord?
6. Read Isaiah 38:1-5. What does this verse show you about the power of prayer? What would have happened to Hezekiah if he had not prayed?
7. Read Isaiah 40:3-5. Who was this prophesy about? Read Matthew 3:1-3 and John 1:19-28. What was the person's role with the coming of Christ?

8. Read verses 9-11. What do we learn about Jesus in these verses?

9. Now read Isaiah 40:27-31. What do we learn about God? What does God promise us?
What do you have to do to have this promise to be true for you?

10. Read Isaiah 41:10. Have you ever cried out to God in fear and been comforted by God knowing that He is with you?

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11. Read Isaiah 42:1-4. Isaiah sees Jesus. He sees what He is like and what He will do.
Look at Matthew 12:18-21. What do we learn about Jesus here?
