DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Ice Breaker Question- 60s, 70s, 80s, 90s: Which decade do you love the most and why?
2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you, or is teaching you, during your personal Bible reading time?
3. What was your main take-away from Pastor Chuck's message this week?
4. What do we learn about God in Isaiah 44:6-8? What are we supposed to do with what we know?
5. Read Isaiah 45:9-10. What is God trying to remind us of here? What are some practical ways we can live this out?
6. Read verses Isaiah 46:12-13. What does God promise in these verses? Have you received these promises?
7. Read 47:8-10. What are some similarities of how people today are drawn away as the Babylonians were?

8. Look at what we are told in 2 Peter 1:19-21. What does this tell you about the prophecies found in the Bible and how we are to view them?

9. Isaiah 49:1-5. Isaiah now shifts his focus to Jesus. The promised Messiah. What do we learn about Jesus 'mission?
