DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Ice Breaker Question: "Who was your childhood famous crush?"
2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you, or is teaching you, during your personal Bible reading time?
3. What was your main take-away from Pastor Chuck's message this week?
4. Do you believe that the lessons we learned from Isaiah are relevant to us today?
5. What is the cycle of dysfunction that the people of Israel found themselves in? Have you seen this cycle played out in your own personal life?
6. Let's read Isaiah 55:2. What is this scripture teaching? What are some examples?
7. Let's read Isaiah 55:6-9. What important truths do we learn from these scriptures?
8. Now let's read John 7:37-39. What important truths do we learn from these scriptures? What does God promise us?
9. What does Jesus say about himself in John 6:35? Why is this important to us as Christians?
