MEMORY VERSE FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER: "The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom."

Isaiah 40:28

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Ice Breaker Question: Would you go to space if you knew that you could never come back to earth?
2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you, or is teaching you, during your personal Bible reading time?
3. What was your main take-away from Pastor Chuck's message this week?
4. As a group, let's start off by looking at what we read together in Isaiah 51:1-20.
 - a. Look also at Galatians 3:6-9; who are Abraham's children?
 - b. What are all of Abraham's children told to do in verses 1-2?
 - c. What promise are we given in verse 3?
 - d. What are we told about God and His salvation in verses 4-6?
 - e. What are we told in verses 7-8?
 - f. What does God say He will do in verse 12?
 - g. What questions does He ask us in verses 12-13?

5. Read Isaiah 52: 7-10. These verses describe the blessing of what we receive when we know and commit our lives to Jesus.
 - a. What does Isaiah tell us about those who are actively sharing the good news of Jesus in verse 7?
 - b. What is the good news we are bringing when we tell others about Jesus? Read Romans 10:12-15; what does Paul say is needed for this good news to go forth?
 - c. What is the result that people will experience when they hear and receive the message of the good news according to verses 8-10?

6. In Chapter 53, Isaiah writes about the things that would happen to Jesus 700 hundred years before they occurred. It is proof that the Bible is true, and God is real that every word we see here was fulfilled by Jesus exactly!
 - a. Why is prophecy necessary?
 - b. Read Isaiah 53:7-18. What did Jesus go through so that we could be forgiven and cleansed from our sins?
 - c. Does it shock you personally to know that these details about Jesus and his death were written down 700 before they happened?
