**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. Ice Breaker Question: What is the most meaningful Christmas gift that you have ever received? What made it so special?
2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you, or is teaching you, during your personal Bible reading time?
3. What was your main take-away from "The Chosen Christmas Special?"
4. At Christmas time there is the whisper, "Love paid a ransom for me." What does this personally mean to you? Do you live your life aware of the love that Jesus has for you?
5. Let's read Isaiah 9:1-7. Who is this prophecy speaking about? What are we promised by God here?
6. Let's read Isaiah 7:14 as a group. What does the name "Immanuel" mean?
7. In "The Chosen," Joseph and Mary, in a moment of need, were shown kindness by the Shepherd. Let's read Proverbs 19:22. Why is kindness so important to God?
8. Let's read Luke 2:10-16. What was the message from the angel? Why is this significant this Christmas season?

9. Read 1 Peter 1:18-21. During the Old Testament, followers of Yahweh would bring a spotless lamb (a perfect and valuable lamb to sacrifice for their sins) to the Tabernacle and the Temple. Have you personally found the spotless lamb in your life? What is holding you back from completely surrendering to Him?
