KEY SCRIPTURE: Romans 1:1-17

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

1. I can experience change when I trust and obey Jesus
 - Luke 6:46 says “Why do you call me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and do not do what I say?”
 - We need FAITH, but faith that you have trust enough to follow Him.
 - Our faith is increased when we respond with obedience
2. I can experience change when I have faith that contributes
 - Everyone has a spiritual gift to contribute
 - It is not for you to use for yourself but to benefit the lives of the other members of your church family
 - We need to focus on contributing instead of achieving
3. I can experience change when I tell others about Christ
 - The Gospel IS the power of God
 - It has the power to change lives

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Are there areas in your life that you still hold on to, and have not allowed God to fully transform?
2. Read Romans 1:1. How does your life look different when you choose to trust God instead of control? If you have not yet allowed God to fully transform you, how would your life look different if you did?
3. What do you think keeps you from giving Him authority over every area of our lives? (Romans 1:3-6)
4. How are we strengthened by our spiritual gifts?
5. Talk about a time when you were encouraged by someone's faith or how you were encouraged by someone else's faith. (Romans 1:11-15)

If group members have not taken their spiritual gifts test, this is a great time to encourage them to do so!
