#### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Ice Breaker Question: If you could choose your age forever, what age would you choose and why?
2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you, or is teaching you, during your personal Bible reading time?
3. What was your main take-away from Pastor Chuck’s message this week?
4. Describe to the group a time when someone let you “off the hook” or showed you grace.
5. Let’s take a look at 1 Peter 4:12-13. What do these verses teach us about trials?
6. Now let’s take a look at Job 28:12-28. What is wisdom according to these scriptures?
7. Let’s read James 1:5-8. What do we learn about wisdom in these verses? What happens when we are double minded as Christians? Now let’s read Hebrews 11:6. Why do we need faith when it comes to asking for Wisdom?
