DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Ice Breaker Question: What was your first car growing up? What was the worst job you ever had? What is your favorite breakfast food?
- 2. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you, or is teaching you, during your personal Bible reading time?
- 3. What was your main take-away from Pastor Chuck's message this week?
- 4. Just like a classic car, God wants to repair and renew you in Him! Let's read Titus 3:3-7. What important lessons do we learn from these verses?
- Pastor Chuck shared 5 life lessons he learned from working on his car with his Dad growing up. The first lesson is "Let go of the old." Let's look at Matthew 9:16-17 and 2 Corinthians 5:17. What do these verses teach us about letting go of the old?

- 7. The 3rd lesson is "Don't give up." Now let's look at 2 Corinthians 3:17-18. How do these verses help us to look forward and not give up?

8. The 4th lesson that Pastor Chuck taught us was to align ourselves with God. Let's read Deuteronomy 5:32 and Proverbs 4:25-27. What do we learn about aligning ourselves to God from these verses?
