DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Ice Breaker Question: What would you say to someone who asked you, what you like most about Crossroads Church?
- 2. We ask this each week to encourage you to be in God's Word Daily. His Word is called our Daily Bread. Share with the group: What is something that God taught you, or is teaching you, during your personal Bible reading time? If you haven't started yet, what's keeping you? Set a goal for this week to spend time in God's Word and share with the group next week?
- 3. What was your main take-away from Pastor Steve's message this week?
- 4. Share with the group of a time when you have been disoriented, lost, confused, lost perspective? What happened?
- 5. Read Mark 8:14-21. If you can take turns in the group each reading a verse. What were the disciples focused on? What did Jesus want there focus to be on?
- 6. What are some things that cause us to lose perspective? If you are willing share with the group the one that happens most in your life?
- 7. What should our perspective be for those who believe in Jesus? Share as many ideas as possible you can with the group to regain the right perspective?
 - a. Verses to read aloud together: Psalm 119:37, Philippians 4:8, 1 Samuel 16:7, Mark 8:25, Proverbs 3:5-6, Hebrews 13:8
- 8. Share a time that you helped someone regain perspective?

9.	Read 1 Timothy 4:1-10. What is the apostle Paul saying here about have the right perspective and what is he warning to be careful of (the wrong perspective)?
