## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. Ice Breaker Question: If you could choose to be any age for the rest of your life, what age would that be? Why?
- 2. Read Luke 9. Why do you think that the disciples did not understand this when Jesus was crucified? What things from God's Word do you find hard to wrap your head around? Why do think that might be?
- 3. Read Luke 24:44-47. Focusing in on verse 45, have there been times when the Holy Spirit has given you insight to a passage of Scripture that you have not been able to see in the past? What kinds of changes have you made in your thought process or behavior as a result?
- 4. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1–4 and 14-20. Why is it that Christianity hinges on the Resurrection? What do you think Paul means in verse 19 when he says we should be pitied if there was only an earthly value to Christianity?
- 5. How is Jesus' resurrection different from the resurrections of Lazarus, or Jarius's daughter? Why is this crucial to our faith?
- 6. Read Ephesians 3:20–21. Recall times in which God gave you even more than what you were expecting, or said "No" because had had something even better planned for you? Share times that it has been hard to wait on God for things we are praying for.
- 7. Read 1 Corinthians 2:9. Even though the Bible says that no one can imagine all of what we will see or hear in heaven, sometimes it's fun to try. What are some of the things you might experience in heaven? What is the one thing that you will be glad to leave behind in this world? Why?
