**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. Ice Breaker Question: What is your favorite song? What is your favorite worship song?
2. In the Book of John, John gives us seven signs that prove that Jesus is the Messiah and the Son of God. Last week we discussed the first 3 signs, below are the last 4 signs: Take time to discuss how these signs impact our lives today.
  - a. More than enough. John 6:1-14
  - b. In the midst of the storm. John 6:1-21, Mark 6:50-52
  - c. The blind receive their sight. Luke 7:22, John 9:32, John 9:1-5
  - d. Jesus came so we could have life. John 10:10, John 11:17-27
3. Have you ever been too tired or doubtful and possibly missed an opportunity for God to do something in your life? Are you willing to share with the group? Read Luke 5:4-9 What was the lesson that he wanted Simon to learn?
3. God is the one who knocks at the door of our hearts calling each of us to a life trusting and following Him. Have you ever thought of what you have sacrificed or would be willing to sacrifice to follow after God? Read Luke 5:10-11.
4. Read Mark 4:35-38 Where was God in the midst of the storm? What did Jesus accuse them of not having? What is the lesson that we need to learn here?
5. There are two stories that we are called to share with others as followers of Jesus. One is called the Good News (The Gospel) = the story of Jesus as our Lord and Savior. The second is the story of how God has impacted and transformed our life. Read Luke 8:32-39. Have you ever shared your story with the group? Take time now if you can or split it up between this week and next week and share.

Look for opportunities to share your story with others. This does not have to be forced but we are told by God to always be prepared to share the hope that you have with others Read 1 Peter 3:15
