MEMORY VERSE FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER:

For just as we have many parts in one body and all the body's parts do not have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually parts of one another.

Romans 12: 4-5

1. Ice breaker Question, If you could ask Jesus one question and you will get the answer to that question, what will it be?
2. Looking back at John 15:12-14 (NASB), Give an example of how Jesus has loved you. Have you shown this same type of Love that Jesus showed you to others when the opportunity presented itself?
3. In 1 John 3:14 (NASB) states, "We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love abides in death". A test of love is knowing that you can love a person apart from their sins, like Jesus did for us, He loved us even though we were sinners. What does this mean to you? Discuss one thing/hang-up that is hard for you to get past as in loving someone or showing God's Love towards them?
4. Read 1 John 4:7-8, The love for a brother or sister in Christ extends past our own borders of Crossroads Christian Church. We are called to approach EVERYONE from a place of love and that love we emulate is of God. How can you show this transcending love to others who you have never met and discuss this with your life group?
5. Review 1 Timothy 1:5 (NASB), How must one love from a pure heart, a good conscience and sincere faith? Give some examples of these that might come up in your everyday life?
6. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:9-10 (NASB), What does it mean to "love your brethren?" Give examples of how you could implement these types of love on a normal basis. How does this look in comparison to how the world views love?
7. Action Point: The Bible clearly states that we need each other. You are a vital part of the Church. The "body" of believers.
