



Seven Deadly Sins Pride

Acts 26:17–18 (NLT)

... Yes, I am sending you to the Gentiles 18 to open their eyes, so they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God. Then they will receive forgiveness for their sins and be given a place among God's people, who are set apart by faith in me.

Opener: As we dig deeper into the deadly sin of Pride, what is your understanding of this sin and is this an area that you find yourself battling with?

1. Read Proverbs 6:16-19. As you read the things the Lord hates, do any of these apply to you? How does Pride birth all these other sins?
2. Read 1 Peter 5:5-7. What is the opposite of Pride? Do you feel that it is sometimes difficult to clothe yourself with humility toward one another? What are ways you can start turning your pride into humility?
3. Read Proverbs 16:18. It is easy to fall into these things the Lord hates, what areas can in our life fall and be destroyed? Read Proverbs 22:4, The Lord is faithful and gives us the strength to overcome our sins. He asks for True Humility, what does this mean to you?

Action point: As you go about your week, examine yourself and catch the areas that may lead you into Pride. Don't let temptation lead you to a path of sin, humble yourself and be led to a life of riches, honor and long life.
