

Opener: What must one do to believe in Jesus Christ? For most of us, We don't automatically start-off as believers in Him. Did something deep down inside call you to faith? Do you think something drew us to believe before we officially accepted Jesus as our Savior?

- 1. Read Luke 9:22 What does this mean to you? As Christians, how does this make you feel about the things we suffer? Think about your loved ones. Are there people in your life you are praying to come to know The Lord?
- 2. Read Luke 12:49-50 Does the weight of how fast time flies add pressure for you to tell your love ones about the Gospel (the Good-News) of Jesus distress you? Jesus was distress in the verse above, discuss this with your Life Group?
- 3. The foundation of the Prophesy is what we hang on to this day and this foundation is rooted in the word of God. Read Luke 24:25-27 In this statement, Jesus calls people out, especially those who know the word of the prophets but choose to follow their own understanding. In what ways do we see this happening with us in today's world? In what ways do you see Christians becoming "Slow of Heart to Believe" when it comes to Jesus' Prophecies?

Call to Action: Today more than ever is the time we need tell our loved ones about what we believe in. Are they hanging on someone else's faith beside their own when it comes to Jesus Christ? This week be "BOLD", ask the HOLY-SPIRIT to empower you to share your faith in Christ. Talk to at least one person whom you love.
