Unstuck † Week 4 "WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU LOSE WHO YOU ARE"

At some time in our lives, most of us have struggled with the question, "Who am I, and why am I here? Pastor Chuck gave us the answer to these questions. "We have a God-given identity, which leads to a God-given purpose." Although that is excellent news, that isn't all we learned. So, let's spend some time unpacking more from Sunday's message. Because God's specific identity for you is the key to getting unstuck.

GETTING TO KNOW YOU

If this is the first time your group has met, take a moment to introduce yourself, share something about your family, and tell the group how you ended up at Crossroads.

Ice Breaker - Share a time when you experienced a mistaken identity moment. Did somebody mistake you for someone else, or did you mistakenly start talking to someone, thinking they were someone else?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 1. The thief constantly tries to get us to doubt our identity in Christ. Share a time when this tactic had you stuck, and how did the promise in <u>John 10:10</u> get you unstuck?
- 2. Who are you? That is a complex question that can only be fully answered with Jesus. How does Jesus change your perspective of yourself?
- 3. <u>Isaiah 5:20</u> is clear, and we can see the confusion in today's culture. How do we prevent ourselves and our families from getting confused?
- 4. When did you figure out who you were?
- 5. How do the following verses and Chuck's statement, "God made you on purpose, with a purpose, for a purpose." shape your identity?

6. Read <u>Ephesians 2:10 NLT</u>. How does being created anew in Christ Jesus change your perspective of who you are?
