1 John Week 3

This week Pastor Chuck talked about who God is. He is the Beginning and the End. We hear about how our identity is under attack. God is outside of space and time. We were created ON PURPOSE in His image. Let's dive into what 1 John says about who God is.

Getting to Know You

1. Describe a time when you had a real encounter with Jesus.
2. Name trials or hardships that you went thru when you came out better in the end.

Digging Deeper

1. Read 1 John 1:1-4 What is something that happened in the past that impacts your life toward Jesus today?
In verse 1, the Greek word for "hear" is "akouo", which means to attend to; something that has happened in the past that impacts today.
 - a. How do you "hear" God?
 - b. Read John 15:11-15 – Who's voice is very recognizable to you?
2. What does it mean when we see something mentioned twice in the Bible? "Truly, truly"
Read Gen 41:32 what is the significance of God doing something more than once?
3. When can we know the Lord? John 1:1-4
4. Look at what the Scriptures say God is.
 - a. Read Revelation 1:8 – What does it mean for Jesus to be the Alpha and Omega?
 - b. Read Colossians 1:15-20

Taking it Home

- How does knowing more about who God is make you feel about who you are in Him? Do you have a newfound assurance in this truth?
- What is something you can do or change in your life to live out your identity in Him in a real way?

Prayer Time

Close your group in prayer. Ask The Lord to speak to you and reveal areas in your life that He needs to touch so you can live your God given purpose.

1. Take time this week to find out how we get to know God better in our on-going experiences.
