1 John

1 John: Week 4: 1 John 1:1-4

Pastor Chuck went over why John is writing to Christians in this letter. Christians are being plagued with false teachings, but John wanted to write Christians so that they wouldn't sin and they would press forward to know the one True God. We are to listen and adhere to the bible and its entirety from the first word of Genesis to the last period in Revelation.

John wants to bring home his experiential relationship with Jesus and how we can have one too. Jesus is the Word of Life and we will only have joy when we start to experience Jesus in a personal way. We were made in the image of God and were created to be relational. Fellowship with others is connected to fellowshipping with God. We are to love one another above all else.

Jesus wants us to have Joy and John shared in the letter of 3rd John that there is nothing that gave him greater joy than when we walk in truth.

- 1) Paul is talking about God's word and truth giving us hope and equipping us for good work in the above verses. What are some of the ways Scriptures has equipped you to do God's work? What do you think God's plans are for you? Does this give you hope?
- 2) John uses the word manifested twice in 1 John 1:2. What does the word manifest mean and why do you think John used it more than once in this verse?
- 3) What has God manifested in your life that increases your faith in living for Him?
- 4) Pastor Chuck told a story in the sermon that talked about the difference between knowing about Jesus, versus really knowing Jesus personally. What is a personal experience you have had with Jesus?
- 5) 1 John 1:4 says These things we write, so that our joy may be made complete. Are there any differences between the word joy and happiness? Is your joy complete?

TAKING IT HOME

Read Hosea 6:3 and discuss what does this truth mean to you.

Pastor Chuck went over how important relationships are and how they are an integral part of how our relationship also works with our Lord and Savior. How does this view of relationships and fellowship with others in conjunction with our personal relationship with God resonate with you?

Pastor Noe said "We don't read the word for information, but for transformation." What part of this sermon resonated with you and is going to help you press on and transform?
