Because of Christ I am not ashamed

Pastor Chuck talked about shame and how it makes us feel terrible about ourselves. Jesus can wipe away shame and free people from it. We never commit a sin that surprises God. God wants us to feel convicted and confess our sins; however, He does not want us to feel shame.
