Pastor Craig went over the difference in writing for these this passage vs. the scripture in the rest of the letter. This section primarily focuses on different stages of maturity within our walk with God and how we relate our past and present situations to what God is doing in our lives.

Pastor Craig also talked about two different Greek terms for children and their usage. Teknia in v12 suggests- children as in a parent/child relationship and could be considered more of a new believer. Paidia in v14 means the subordination of the child and Pastor Craig goes on to say that paidia can also mean the subordination under the teaching and authority of scripture. Are we ready to subordinate ourselves to the authority of Christ?
