- 5. Read James 2:8 13. What are the implications here?

TAKING IT HOME

By showing favoritism, we break the command to love our neighbor as ourselves, thereby transgressing the entire law and exposing ourselves to judgment without mercy.

What passage refers to loving your neighbor as yourself? (don't google it. Test yourselves!)

In your closing prayer, ask God to dispel the sin of favoritism. Breakout into smaller groups and pray for each other. Then come back together and pray together.
